

Report to Calgary Centre

Greg McLean, MP

Working on behalf of Calgary Centre constituents

- 1. Much of my time has been spent helping constituents **navigate the COVID aid programs** which are often complex and confusing, and to help fix them when possible. For example, I advocated to get grant money often a major source of income for artists accepted as "eligible income" to qualify for CERB/CRB. I also pressed for a change to the rent subsidy criteria for small businesses because the initial program had blocked many from qualifying.
- 2. I am working intensely to **bring attention to the job losses** that will occur across Canada if Michigan succeeds in cancelling Enbridge's Line 5 easement. That pipeline supplies oil to refineries in Eastern Canada and, needless to say, its cancellation would be another blow following on the heels of Keystone's cancellation for people working in Alberta's oil and gas industry, as well as for people whose jobs depend on supplying goods and services to a healthy oil and gas industry.
- 3. True to my representations and beliefs, I voted to support the government bill to ban so-called "conversion therapy" ("therapy" is clearly the wrong word) and I have supported the government's updated Medical Assistance in Dying ("MAiD") legislation.
- 4. It was a pleasure to submit a new Private Members Bill to use the tax system to facilitate **Carbon Capture**, **Utilization and Storage (CCUS)**. This tax credit is designed to enable Canadian companies to utilize new technologies in contributing significantly to reducing airborne greenhouse gas emissions. Alberta and Saskatchewan have led the world in this technology development in the past; this change will put us back into a position as world leaders on reaching emissions reduction targets.
