PARLIAMENTARY REPORT SUMMER 2021

Shadow Minister for Natural Resources

During this session of Parliament I have had to spend considerable time standing up for Alberta's economic interests, including Enbridge's Line 5 which carries vital oil from Alberta for refining into fuel for Ontario, Quebec and several US states.

I have also had the pleasure of visiting numerous high technology companies in Calgary and seeing diversification in action. Several are developing clean energy solutions such as converting captured carbon to useful products. Others are using technology as the foundation for innovative new products, such as at Canadian UAVs, where I saw the WhiskyJack, used in heavy industry, infrastructure and defence applications.

My work in Parliament included:

- Introduced a Private Members Bill to support Carbon Capture, Utilization & Storage to make Canadian industry competitive. The Liberals defeated it.
- Voted in favour of the government's bill to ban "conversion therapy", a cruel practice that tries to "fix" LGBTQ2S+ Canadians.
- Highlighted to all Parliamentarians the exceptional work being done in Calgary on new clean energy technologies.
- Advocated for greater transparency and accountability for the government's promise to achieve net zero emissions by 2050.
- Pressed the government to provide a plan to develop critical minerals, used in high tech and clean energy industries, so that China doesn't come to dominate the market for these essential inputs.
- Joined my colleagues in fighting Bill C-10 which has the potential to allow the CRTC to monitor individuals' posts on social media. So far, the bill is stalled.
